2024 CYCLE Program Official Rules

The program is open to all high school sophomores living in or attending school in Three Rivers Electric Cooperative's service territory. Applicants need not be a cooperative member. Immediate family members (sons and daughters, sisters, brothers, or grandchildren) of Three Rivers' employees or directors are ineligible.

- All entries must be postmarked or in the drop box at the Linn or Brazito office no later than **Monday, February 19**. Mailing address: Three Rivers Electric Cooperative Attention : CYCLE Coordinator P.O. Box 918, Linn, MO. We prefer applications to be mailed or hand delivered to either the Linn or Brazito office. Applications submitted by email should be sent to lkiso@threeriverselectric.com. Make sure to include a cover sheet and type CYCLE application in the subject line.

- Applications will be sent to area cooperatives for review and judging. Twelve students will be chosen as finalists. The six students receiving the highest grade on their application will attend the CYCLE conference and the remaining six students will each receive a \$50 gift card. The decision of the judges is final.
