

Applications are due by March 6, 2026

Five scholarships of \$2,000 each will be awarded to eligible students. A three-person judging panel will review all applications, interview the top candidates, and select the scholarship recipients.

Eligibility:

Applicants must be high school seniors whose parent(s) or guardian(s) are members of Three Rivers Electric Cooperative.

Selection Process:

- A panel of three independent judges, not affiliated with Three Rivers Electric Cooperative, will evaluate all applications.
- Applicants will be scored based on financial need, interview performance, and other listed criteria.
- The top applicants will be invited for in-person interviews, which will take place at the Cooperative's headquarters in Linn on a date set by the judges.
- Finalists must attend the interview to remain eligible for the scholarship.

Award Presentation:

Scholarships will be awarded during the Cooperative's annual membership meeting in August.

This scholarship program is part of Three Rivers Electric Cooperative's ongoing commitment to support and invest in the future of its members by helping the next generation achieve their educational goals.

Three Rivers Electric Cooperative is pleased to announce the application process for the Gilbert G. Hilkemeyer Scholarship. The scholarship was established in 1991 in honor of former manager Gilbert Hilkemeyer to provide assistance to students within our service area who want to attend college or learn a skill in a vocational institution. Eligible schools include public, private, junior colleges and vocational institutions within the State of Missouri.

Five \$2,000 scholarships will be awarded, with recipients receiving their checks at the Co-op's Annual Meeting on the first Friday in August. A three-person committee will review all applications, conduct interviews with the finalists, and select the scholarship recipients based on the interview, grade point average, ACT scores, involvement in school, church, and community activities, and letters of recommendation.

Eligible students are high school seniors whose parents or guardians are members of Three Rivers Electric Cooperative.
