## Foundation Update April – June 2020

There were 11 applications reviewed in the second quarter of 2020.

6 – Individual or Family applications – all approved for a total of \$11,090.08

5 – Organization or Agency applications – all approved for a total of \$30,379

## **Approved Applications**

Bland Fire Protection District was awarded \$6,000 to assist with purchasing a standby generator and an air compressor.

Two individuals received a total of \$1,999.75 to assist with dental expenses.





Owensville Senior Center was awarded \$5,000 to assist with providing meals for their homebound program and at the center.

Two individuals received a total of \$3,090.33 to assist with medical and dental expenses.

Cole County Fire Protection District was awarded \$10,000 to assist with installing transfer switches at several fire stations for the ability to connect a portable generator.



One family received a total of \$5,000 to assist with expenses resulting from a house fire and one family received \$1,000 in emergency assistance due to a house fire.

OATS Transit was awarded \$4,000 to assist with transportation expenses for disabled and elderly individuals residing in Osage and Miller Counties.

Osage County Anti-Drug Community Action Team (OCACAT) was awarded \$5,379 to assist with providing anti-drug programs for children in Osage County.
